Sub: Depression over southeast & adjoining east-central Arabian Sea

The depression over southeast & adjoining eastcentral Arabian Sea slightly moved northwestward and lay centred at 1730 hrs IST of today, the 6th October 2018 near latitude 11.3°N and longitude 66.9°E, about 1500 km southeast of Salalah (Oman), 1400 km east-southeast of Socotra Islands (Yemen) and 750 km west-northwest of Minicoy (Lakshadweep Islands). It is very likely to intensify further into a Cyclonic Storm during next 24 hours. It is very likely to move northwestwards towards South Oman & adjoining Yemen Coasts during next 5 days.

Warnings:

(i) Heavy rainfall warning for Tamil Nadu & Puducherry, Kerala and Lakshadweep in association with cyclonic storm and easterly wave.

(ii) Wind warning

- Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph very likely over Lakshadweep and southeast Arabian Sea on 6th and 7th October.
- Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph very likely over central Arabian Sea on 6th. The wind speed will gradually increase becoming 60-70 kmph gusting to 80 kmph on 8th October 2018. It will also increase thereafter.

(iii) Sea condition

• The sea condition would become rough to very rough from today the 6th October over southeast Arabian Sea and adjoining central Arabian Sea. It will become gradually high over central Arabian Sea around system centre from 7th evening/ 8th morning.

(iv) Fishermen Warning

- The fishermen are advised not to venture into deep sea areas of southeast and Lakshadweep area during 6th and 7th October and into east central Arabian Sea from 6th to 9th October and west-central Arabian Sea from 8-11 October.
- The fishermen out at deep Sea are advised to return to coast.
